



Directions to Redline Software Ltd, First floor, Mount Pleasant House, Lonsdale Gardens, Tunbridge Wells, Kent, TN1 1NY



By Road

Royal Tunbridge Wells is situated on the A26 and A21 routes from London to the south coast and can be reached from both the M20 (Junction 4) and M25 (Junction 5) motorways within 20 minutes by car.

From the M25

- Leave the M25 at Junction 5 for the A21 towards Sevenoaks.
- Remain on the A21 for 13.9 miles taking the A264 exit to Royal Tunbridge Wells.
- Join the A264 (Pembury Road). Continue for 1.7 miles.
- At the traffic lights (The Royal Oak pub is on the opposite left hand side), turn onto Calverley Road.
- Continue to the roundabout, take the first exit onto Crescent Road.
- Turn left onto Mount Pleasant Road (A26).
- Turn right into Lonsdale Gardens.
- Mount Pleasant House is situated on right hand side opposite The Barn public house

From the M20

- Leave the M20 at junction 4 and join the A228, and subsequently the A26 towards Tonbridge.
- Before reaching the centre of Tonbridge the A26 turns left (Cannon Lane).
- Pass over the river and follow the A26 to the third roundabout.
- Turn left to join the Southbound A21, but leave the A21 at the next slip road exit for the A264 and Royal Tunbridge Wells. (follow as from the third bullet point "From the M25" above)

By Rail

Tunbridge Wells is on the mainline rail service from Charing Cross to Hastings. Direct services run at regular intervals stopping at London Bridge, Waterloo East, Sevenoaks and Tonbridge. Services take approximately 50 minutes from Charing Cross. There are also connecting services to Gatwick Airport and Ashford International stations. Air

Gatwick Airport, Heathrow Airport and Stansted Airport are all within easy reach of Tunbridge Wells. By car Gatwick is 40 minutes, Heathrow 60 minutes and Stansted 80 minutes from Tunbridge Wells.
